In the event of serious inclement weather, Little Flower School will follow all the directives and policies issued by Washoe County School District. Announcements are made on the local radio and television stations, if schools are closed or on a delayed start. You may also check the LFS web site for more information. We will also attempt to notify you via MyStudentsProgress.com. Please drop your child(ren) off no earlier than ½ hour before school starts on delayed start days, that is when there will be supervision.

Dismissal Reminders

Students must remain inside the fenced area on the playground, they are not allowed to walk down Casazza Drive to meet their ride.

Please note that at 3:00 p.m., the parking lot is a very busy place. Watch for students crossing, drive slowly, and observe the 5 mph speed limit. Also, please try to avoid using your cell phone while driving through the parking lot, there is so much going on and it is easy to be distracted. The safety of the children is first for all of us. PLEASE...always exit on Casazza Drive, NOT Plumb Lane. On Casazza Drive the far west lane is the entrance to the parking lot; when exiting from the center exit, turn left or go straight, and turn right from the east exit. Please follow the arrows.

If students are not picked up by 1:00 p.m. on early dismissal days or by 3:30 p.m. on regular days, they will be moved to the After School Program and charged the \$10.00 drop-in rate on regular days or \$15.00 on minimum days. Parents must be responsible to pick up their children promptly each day.
